COXWAIN'S UPDATE

Up date on winter developments:-

The start to this year has been quiet on the callout front, but as usual there has been a great deal happening to keep all the equipment in good working order, the main task this winter was to install two new outboard engines on the Lifeboat. We were unable to fit like for like engines as the ones which had served us well no longer complied with emissions regulations, these engines were two and a half years old, so were sold on while they still had some value.

There has been a great deal of time spent trying to decide which type of engine and what size to fit, after a trip to E.P.Barrus near Oxford and a trip to Sidmouth Lifeboat to see their boat the Trustees ordered two Mariner Optimax outboard engines from E.P. Barrus.

The new engines are more powerful giving an increased speed for the Lifeboat, but there are also many more advantages, primarily more power available when we are towing other boats, better fuel economy, better starting and quieter running, allowing the crew to hear each other and radio messages better.

Our thanks to Barrus, Advance Marine of Portishead who installed the engines and Portishead Marina who allowed the use of crane facilities to get the new engines fitted.

Some of you may have seen the Lifeboat on sea trials around the Christmas period, it may have appeared that we were out 'playing' during this time, but in fact we were testing various propellers to get the right ones for the boat fitted, once this had been done all the crew had to familiarise them selves with the new more powerful engines as this changed the handling characteristics of

the boat, as you can imagine the time not to get used to new equipment is on a callout, so the Coxswains and crew all had time to become comfortable with the new set up.

Whilst the Lifeboat was off station we had a reserve boat on stand by from Portishead Marina and several maintenance jobs on the boathouse were carried out.

The trainee crew who started with us in September are now well into their training schedule and are now training on the water with the existing crew, we have had a mixed bag of weather this Winter which has given us some good training sessions, notably fog, several trips to Newport were completed successfully in fog, giving the crew good experience in navigation and the use of our electronic systems on the boat.

We are all wondering what this year has in store for us, as usual The Portishead Lifeboat will be kept in a state of readiness to respond to what ever situation arises.
